# RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS FOR THE VISIT TO THE UNITED KINGDOM BY A HEAD OF STATE 3-5 JUNE 2019 

1 A Head of State is to visit the United Kingdom during the period from $\mathbf{3}$ to 5 June 2019 inclusive. The visit will include a visit to D-Day 75th anniversary events at Southsea, Hampshire. As part of the overarching security plan, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided it necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.

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The charts in this document relate to the areas defined in the associated text; all areas will be subject to NOTAM action; these are to be read in conjunction with this document. Pilots are strongly encouraged to employ the use of moving map technology and/or an air traffic service to mitigate the risk of inadvertent airspace infringements. This briefing notice should also be read in conjunction with AIC M 057/2019 (RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS - D-DAY 75TH ANNIVERSARY FLYPAST PORTSMOUTH AND THE ISLE OF WIGHT - 5 JUNE 2019) and AIC M 058/2019 (RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS - D-DAY 75TH ANNIVERSARYPORTSMOUTH, HAMPSHIRE - 5 JUNE 2019).

The times mentioned in this Notice are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time.

3 JUNE 2019
CHART 1 - AREA A - BETWEEN LONDON STANSTED AIRPORT AND CENTRAL LONDON
Subject to paragraph 4 between 0730 hours and 0930 hours on 3 June 2019 no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 FT AMSL within the area displayed on Chart 1 as AREA A and bounded successively by:
a) a straight line joining the following points:
i. $\quad 514508 \mathrm{~N} 0001309 \mathrm{E}$;
ii. $\quad 514055 \mathrm{~N} 0000652 \mathrm{E}$; and
iii. 513232 N 0000055 W ; and
b) the anticlockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 17 NM centred on 512812 N 0002713 W from 513232 N 0000055 W to 513611 N 0000311 W ; and
c) straight lines joining the following points:

d) the anticlockwise arc of a circle having a radius of radius 8 NM centred on 515306 N 0001406 E from 515155 N 0000120 E to 514508N 0001309E.

Subject to paragraph 13, between $\mathbf{1 3 0 0}$ hours and 1415 hours on 5 June 2019, no aircraft is to fly below 3,000 FT AMSL within the area displayed on Chart 3 as AREA F and bounded by:
a) straight lines joining successively the following points:
i. 504952 N 0011702 W ;
ii. 510130N 0011058W
iii. 505445 N 0010338 W ; and
b) the anticlockwise arc of a circle having a radius of 8 NM centred on 504650 N 0010521 W from 505445 N 0010338 W to 504952N 0011702W

Paragraph 12 does not apply to any aircraft:
a) making an approach to, or departing from, Southampton Airport whilst under the control of the air traffic control unit at Southampton Airport; or
b) operated by:
i. the National Police Air Service;
ii. the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or
iii. the Maritime and Coastguard Agency; or
iv. The Queen's Helicopter Flight; or
c) operated with the authority of the Metropolitan Police Service who may be contacted at restrictedairspace@met.police.uk.

Due to these restrictions of flying regulations, the Bishops Waltham Flying Area is not to be used between 1300 hours and 1415 hours on 5 June 2019. No aircraft is to operate into or out of Lower Upham or Roughay Aerodromes during these times.
