

Following the popularity and success of our previous ****Over-Nighter**** when we went to Abbeville, I am organising another, this time, to Cherbourg Maupertus [LFRC].

A reminder of the concept: Between the Monthly One-Day Fly-outs organised by PAFRA, and the Whole Week Tour I organise each summer, there is a place in our Flying Calendar for an ***Over-Nighter** i.e. 24 hours away with a onenight stay somewhere: A place where we can relax together in a convenient hotel; have a meal; (+ drink without the worry of having to fly again too soon!); share 'hangar talk' etc.; and/or just 'chill out'.

Our Route: FRIDAY

From Rochester, in order to clear Immigration, we could either fly in the morning via Le Touquet (2 hrs PPR); or direct to Cherbourg (24 hrs PPR). At either stage, we can have a late leisurely lunch at the airfield restaurant: *L'Escale* in Le Touquet; or at Le Coucou de Fourchette (The Cuckoo Fork!) as guests of Edith et Luc Dufou (see below).

That night we would stay in Cherbourg. In the evening, we would have a meal together on the Cherbourg Marina Quai at
