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## GUIDANCE NOTES

### GUIDANCE NOTE 1: Important Information

A copy of this declaration is to be retained by the pilot and the ATO/RFT/DTO/Flying Club

Please note that for pilot's applying for this declaration, the following requirements will need to be met;

- Hold a valid Licence (that is a licence that is not subject to suspension, limitation or other enforcement action by the issuing authority)
- Hold a valid, current rating relevant to the aircraft to be operated, and the privileges to be exercised, demonstrable by reference to appropriate log book and licence evidence
- Hold at least a valid Class 2 Medical issued by the issuing authority
- Hold an "English proficient" endorsement on their ICAO licence, to meet the minimum level 4 proficiency, or have their proficiency confirmed by a UK CAA Approved Language Proficiency Assessment Centre if no such endorsement applies or the candidate wishes to be credited with proficiency levels 5 or 6 (Form **SRG1199** applies).

### GUIDANCE NOTE 3: Supporting documentation required with the application

- The original or certified true copies of your current Third Country ICAO licence and medical.
- The original or certified true copies of flying log book(s)
- The original or a certified true copy of your valid Passport, EEA/EU Nationals Identity Card or full EU photographic Driving Licence.
- Completed application form SRG2142 for the verification of your Third Country ICAO licence.

Copies of the above documents should be certified by the Flight Instructor conducting the acclimatising flight.

Please note that you may be required to meet additional requirements as set out by the National Aviation Authority (NAA) that issued your ICAO licence, in order for them to release your personal information to the UK CAA.

The UK CAA will only accept the verification directly from the NAA that issues the ICAO licence, and it will remain valid for six months from the date of receipt.

### GUIDANCE NOTE 4: What happens next?

The UK CAA will apply to the National Aviation Authority that issued your Third Country ICAO licence for verification.

Once we have received the verification and assessed that you meet the requirements based on the documentation provided, the UK CAA will send an email confirming this.
