Air Navigation (Jersey) Order 2008

Exercise of the privileges of Instrument Meteorological Conditions Ratings in Channel Islands Airspace

1. The Director of Civil Aviation for Jersey, in exercise of his power under article 153 of the Air Navigation (Jersey) Order 2008, ("the Order"), hereby exempts all holders of an Instrument Meteorological Conditions Rating (IMC) issued by the UK Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) from the requirements of article 26 of the Order insofar as it applies to the exercise of the privileges of the IMC Rating outside of the United Kingdom area of authority, requiring that a person shall not act as a member of the flight crew of an aircraft unless he is the holder of an appropriate licence granted or rendered valid by the law of the country in which the aircraft is registered or the State of the operator and satisfying the minimum standards established under Annex 1 to the Chicago Convention, subject to the conditions in paragraph 2 of this exemption.
2. Conditions of the Exemption:
 - a. The exemption is valid only for flights within Jersey airspace and the Channel Islands Control Zone.
 - b. Flights shall be subject to the privileges and conditions of the IMC rating granted by the UK CAA.
 - c. Flights shall be subject to operating within the meteorological limits notified for Jersey airspace in the UK Aeronautical Information Publication.
 - d. The original IMC Rating and holder's pilot licence must be valid in all respects for this exemption to be effective.

3. This exemption shall come into force on 22 January 2014 and remain valid until varied, suspended or revoked.
4. References to articles in the Order are references to the Air Navigation (Jersey) Order, 2008 and shall, on modification or replacement of that Law, be construed accordingly
